

Fire Speaks Scotland: Heart & Hearth 10-12th June 2022

TRAVELLING TO THE VENUE BY PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Edinburgh is well served by public transport (bus, train and air). General information about getting to Edinburgh is provided below.

The venue for this first **Fire Speaks: Heart & Hearth** in Scotland is, [Broomlee Outdoor Education Centre](#), which is 14 miles south of Edinburgh, near the village of West Linton. Once in Edinburgh, public transport to, Broomlee Centre, is by bus from [Edinburgh Bus Station](#) to West Linton and then a 5min taxi journey (or 20min walk!) to the Broomlee Centre - [see route map here](#) and further details and journey planner below.



BUS 101/A EDINBURGH TO WEST LINTON (1hr)

The bus service to West Linton is the **101/A service, Edinburgh to Dumfries, via West Linton**, operated by Stagecoach. The **101/A bus** departs from Edinburgh Bus Station, St Andrews Square ([located here](#)), from Gate E St 7. The journey time from Edinburgh to West Linton is approximately 1 hour. Bus tickets are £3.50 each way. On weekdays the 101/A bus service runs every hour between 8am and 9pm. However, on Sundays there are only four services - see times of the relevant services below for check-in from 4pm at Broomlee Centre on Friday 10th June and departure after 12 noon on Sunday 12th June.

Bus 101/A Times

Friday (out)

Depart Edinburgh Bus Station, Gate E St 7:

2.20pm or 3.30pm

Arrive West Linton:

3.23pm or 4.33pm

Sunday (return)

Depart West Linton

11.56am or 2.56pm

Arrive Edinburgh

12.58pm or 3.58pm

Alight from the bus at the West Linton bus stop, just before the Gordon Arms pub and restaurant. It maybe helpful to familiarise yourself with the bus stop on Google Street View, [here](#)

TAXI FROM WEST LINTON TO BROOMLEE CENTRE (5mins)



Once at West Linton, the Broomlee Centre is 1 mile outside of the village - a 5min car journey or a 20min walk. A local taxi service is available from West Linton to the Broomlee Centre. **This must be booked in advance** and is a **fixed fee of £10 per journey.**

WALK FROM WEST LINTON TO BROOMLEE CENTRE (20mins)

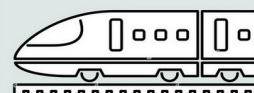

Edinburgh Airport is an international airport served from more than 150 domestic and international locations, [see here](#).



Edinburgh Airport is connected to Edinburgh City Centre by [Tram](#), which stops 1 min walk from Edinburgh Bus Station at St Andrews Square in the City Centre. There is also an Edinburgh [Airport Bus](#) that stops on South St David's Street, which is 7 mins walk from Edinburgh Bus Station. Glasgow Airport is well connected to Edinburgh and is also served by many domestic and international locations, [see here](#).

Getting from Glasgow Airport is by Airport bus into Glasgow City Centre and then on by train from Glasgow to Edinburgh Waverley train station. 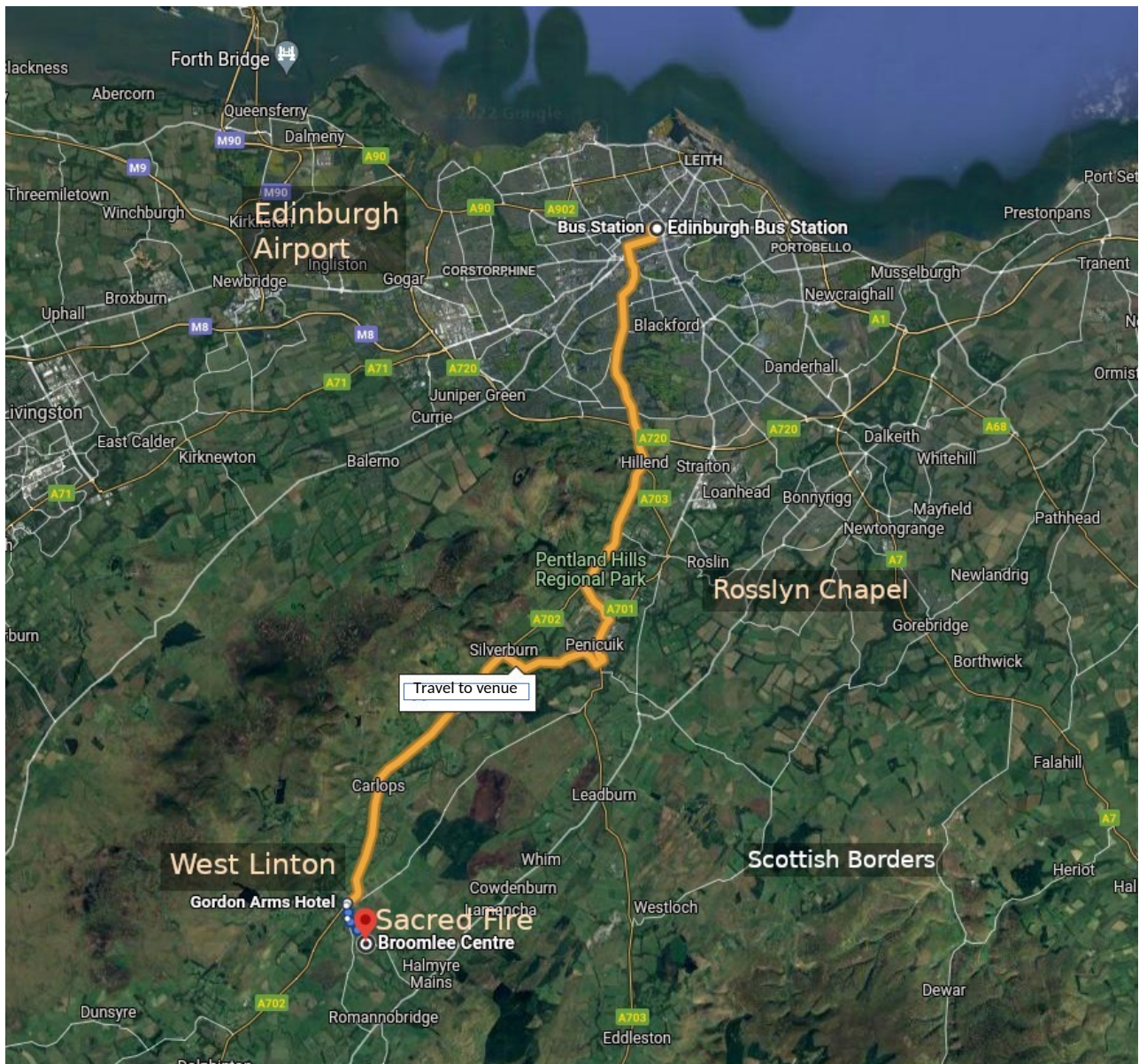
